- Any Shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the 2025 AGM shall be entitled to appoint another person (who must be an individual) as his/her/its proxy to attend and vote instead of him/her/it and a proxy so appointed shall have the same right as the Shareholder to speak at the 2025 AGM. On a poll, votes may be given either personally or by proxy. A proxy need not be a Shareholder. A Shareholder may appoint more than one proxy to attend on the same occasion. For the avoidance of doubt, holders of treasury shares of the Company (if any) are not entitled to vote at the 2025 AGM.
- This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either executed under its seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised. If the form of proxy is signed by an attorney of the Shareholder, the power of attorney authorising that attorney to sign or other document(s) of authorisation must be notarized.
- In order to be valid, this form of proxy for the 2025 AGM must be deposited at (i) the Company’s principal place of business in the PRC at No. 1, Xinyi Avenue South, Dingbao Town, Xinyi City, Maoming City, Guangdong Province, China (for holders of Unlisted Shares) or (ii) the Company’s H Share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong (for holders of H Shares) not less than 24 hours (i.e. not later than 9 a.m. on Thursday, 14 May 2026) before the time for holding the 2025 AGM (or any adjournment thereof) for taking the poll. If the form of proxy is signed by a person under a power of attorney or other authority, a notarial copy of that power of attorney or authority shall be deposited at the same time as mentioned in the form of proxy. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude Shareholders from attending and voting in person at the 2025 AGM or any adjourned meetings should they so wish.
- In case of joint Shareholder for any share, only the person whose name is at the first place on the register of members of the Company has the rights to receive the certificate of relevant shares and notice from the Company and to attend or exercise all of the votes relating to the shares.
- Shareholders or their proxies shall provide their identity documents when attending the 2025 AGM.
